

The Cottie & Cake Fund was established in 2011 by Meghan Russ Hampton and her mother, Fran Russ. In 2010, Meghan faced a high-risk pregnancy and gave birth to twin girls, Katelynn (Kate - pronounced "Cake" by big sister, Ella) and Scotlynn (Scottie - "Cottie"). Kate did not survive and Scottie spent 10 weeks at Levine Children's Hospital fighting for her life.

Grateful for the amazing care they received, the Hamptons, along with their family and friends, were motivated to get others involved in supporting the NICN and Charlotte Fetal Care Center - both places where their family witnessed miracles. The Fund supports programs, equipment, and research that directly impacts the lives of other families who are facing similar experiences.
